

## MENU

The following is a small representation of the many delectable items to choose from. Items are served a la carte so that you may enjoy the various authentic foods of our Parish Community.

### Greek

#### Souvlaki (Kabobs)

Succulent barbequed morsels of marinated lamb served with tatziki sauce

#### Pastitsio (Greek Lasagna)

A Greek classic! Ground beef sautéed with, onions, tomatoes and a secret blend of herbs and spices and baked together with macaroni, and Greek cheeses and a béchamel sauce.

### Romanian

#### Sarmale (Cabbage roll)

Pork, rice, onion and spices perfectly rolled in cabbage leaves in a tomato, sauerkraut sauce. Also known as sarma in Serbia, galuptze in Russia, holishkes in Eastern Europe, & dolmas in Armenia. Each with it's own variation.

#### Tocanita

Chicken prepared with mushrooms and white wine, onions, green peppers, tomatoes, & sour cream

### Russian

#### Piroshki

Baked bread fried stuffed with potato & onions OR fried cabbage

#### Pelmini

Meat filled boiled dumplings served with butter or sour cream

### Serbian

#### Kobasi, Sauerkrat & Politse

Layers of sauerkraut, kobasi (pork sausage), politse (potatoes) & cheese combined with special seasonings

### From the Grill

#### Lamb Sandwich

Roasted lamb on a fresh roll with tomato & lettuce

### Desserts / Bake Sale

#### Greek Baklava

Filo dough layered with chopped walnuts, honey and spices baked to a golden crisp

#### Russian Rum Baba

A heavy cake with nuts, glazed with rum & butter & served with whipped cream

#### Russian Povitica

A traditional holiday nut bread hand rolled to perfection. Also popular in Serbia.
